- Private transfers from Termini train station (or a designated hotel) in Rome on the first day of the tour and Florence's Santa Maria Novella train station (or a designated hotel) on the final day
- All land transfers within Tuscany are by air-conditioned minibus with private driver
- Small, personalised and private group (max 12 participants)

Tour fee does not include:

- Pre-tour accommodation. It is highly recommended that you arrive in Europe 2 or more days prior to commencement of the tour, to allow you to overcome any symptoms resulting from jet lag. This will maximise your enjoyment of the first few days on the tour.

Tour Payments

- The balance (including Single Supplement, if payable) must be paid by Friday 16 February 2024. Late payments may incur additional costs.

Cancellation Policy

Fit To Travel Form

Tour participation requires a reasonable degree of both physical fitness and mental wellbeing. The ability to confidently climb slopes, steps and navigate uneven terrain, unaided, is essential. Participants should be capable of 4 - 5 hours of moderate walking at a time. Participants should be willing to safely self-reflect and share in a group context, whilst allowing space for and respecting individual differences.

It is a condition of In giro Tours that any traveller booked to travel with us has a certain level of physical and mental fitness. Please consider any fitness issues you may have before making a tour booking and placing a deposit. It is important that you understand that the tour will require some walking and climbing and will involve getting in and out of a minibus and includes several boat trips.

This tour includes facilitated group and individual processes designed to support you to reflect and feel deeply. A supported, psychologically safe environment will be provided as much as possible but it is expected that prospective participants will not attend if they are living with unmanaged mental illness/trauma or fragile mental health. Participants with a history of mental illness or trauma are encouraged to speak with the program facilitator ahead of booking.

It is the expectation that upon booking with In giro Tours any issues with your fitness will not impede the enjoyment of the tour for any of the remaining participants. In giro Tours, Ingrid Gaiotto and Lucy Mayes will not be held liable for any activities or sightseeing missed due to the inability of any participant to keep up with the tour group or to manage the psychological landscape of deep personal and group reflection.

You agree that we cannot have any knowledge of any other medical issues that you may have and that we may request you to provide a medical certificate prior to accepting your booking if your Fit to Travel Form discloses any matters of concern.

In giro Tours reserves the right to decline any prospective traveller if they are concerned about the traveller's ability to participate in the tour or who may require services and/or facilities that In giro Tours cannot guarantee will be available.

You agree not to hold In giro Tours responsible for any decision made by a third party service provider who may refuse to carry you or provide any service to you.

Additionally, you agree that In giro Tours is not held liable for any damage, injury or loss of any kind arising from any pre-existing medical condition or from your failure to disclose any relevant medical information.
